

Policeman shot down in apparent drug find

United Press International DALLAS — One man was being held Tuesday in the shooting death of a policeman who apparently interrupted a drug transaction in an apartment parking lot.

Officer Ronald D. Baker, who was patrolling alone, was shot and killed in the parking lot of the Georgetown Apartments in southeast Dallas about 11:30 a.m. Monday, said police spokesman Bob Shaw.

A witness said two men jumped into a van and drove over Baker as they escaped from the scene. Authorities said three or four other people were believed to have been in the van.

United Press International AUSTIN — Supporters of mandatory auto restraints for children used "Save a Child Day" Tuesday to pressure the Texas House to approve a Senate-passed bill that requires safety seats for children under age 4.
