



# U.S. biships condemn nuclear weapons race

United Press International CHICAGO — The nation's Roman Catholic bishops, responding to what they say is a new moment in the nuclear era, have sharply condemned the nuclear arms race and called for

new initiatives to halt it. They supported what one bishop called the concept of a nuclear freeze and used language that is almost exactly that of the freeze movement in urging a halt in the testing, production and deployment of new nuclear weapons systems. But they carefully dissociated themselves from any specific political proposals for a freeze.

They said they avoided the exact language of a freeze proposal now before Congress, because they did not want to be identified with a specific politic-al initiative or to have their own with either cheers or angry words used against specific political measure.
