Farmers alter tilling methods

United Press International WASHINGTON—Research by the Agriculture Department shows many farmers are switching from traditional deep-tillage equipment to conservation tillage practices.
 Economists Lee Christensen and Richard Magleby of the department's Natural Resources Economics Division suggest that several factors are behind the change.
 "Economic pressures have encouraged farmers to adopt cost-saving practices, particular-

ly those that reduce fuel use or crop production," they said. "Fewer field operations mean lower fuel bills and maybe some savings on labor costs."
 Christensen and Magleby said another factor is the increase in double-cropping of wheat and soybeans.

A third factor, the two economists said, is that conservation tillage preserves more moisture for plant growth and that can be a key advantage in some moisture-short areas of the West.

Finally, the growing popularity of conservation tillage practices reflects a greater conservation consciousness on the part of farmers, they said, as well as a general public and governmental concern. Unlike conventional tillage, where all the topsoil is mixed and inverted through plowing, conservation tillage focuses on minimizing soil disturbance and leaving plant residues on the surface.

The department noted that the practices vary from north to south where only the area around the seed zone is prepared, to the more common minimum tillage where the entire field surface may be worked with some form of limited tillage.

According to data published by "No-Till Farmer," U.S. acreage in minimum tillage increased 157 percent and acreage in no-till increased 137 percent from 1973 to 1982, while at the same time acreage in conventional tillage showed almost no change.

Popularity of conservation tillage varies greatly by region. In 1982, it accounted for almost half of the tilled area, 47 percent, in the 12-southeastern area comprised of Florida, Georgia, Alabama, Mississippi, Louisiana, Arkansas, Tennessee, North Carolina, South Carolina, Virginia, West Virginia and Kentucky.

Conservation tillage also is used in a third or more of the crop area in the Corn Belt-Great Lakes region, the Northeast and the Rocky Mountain states. In the Great Plains and Pacific region, however, conservation tillage was used on only one-fourth and one-fifth of the acreage, respectively.

Christensen and Magleby said the wide differences in use are caused by differing soil types with yields responding better to some soil types than others.
