## 10% Astros score late to beat Chicago

United Press International CHICAGO — Terry Puhl got Chicago relief pitcher Bill Campbell right where he wanted him.

Puhl slammed a two-run triple to give the Houston Astros a 9-7 triumph over the Chicago Cubs Monday.

The game was tied 7-7 when Alan Ashby opened the eighth inning with a single and moved to second on a balk. Campbell, 1-2, struck out the next two batters and after going 2-and-0 he intentionally walked Omar Moreno. Puhl followed with his first game-winning hit of the

'I wanted him (Campbell) to get the ball up. He was 2-and-0 and had to come to me," Puhl said. "It didn't surprise me that they walked Moreno. They were

going for the easy way out."

Bill Buckner's second home run of the game — his fourth in three days — had tied the contest 7-7 in the Cubs' sixth.

Phil Garner's run-scoring single gave the Astros a 1-0 lead in the first. In the bottom of the inning, an error by second base-man Craig Reynolds allowed the Cubs' first run and then RBI singles by Ron Cey and Keith Moreland padded the lead to 3-

Buckner homered in the second, but in the fourth, Jose Cruz hit his second homer and an RBI single by Reynolds cut Chicago's lead to 4-3. Lee



and later in the day notified the team that he needed help. In 14 games this season, Howe has not allowed an earned


