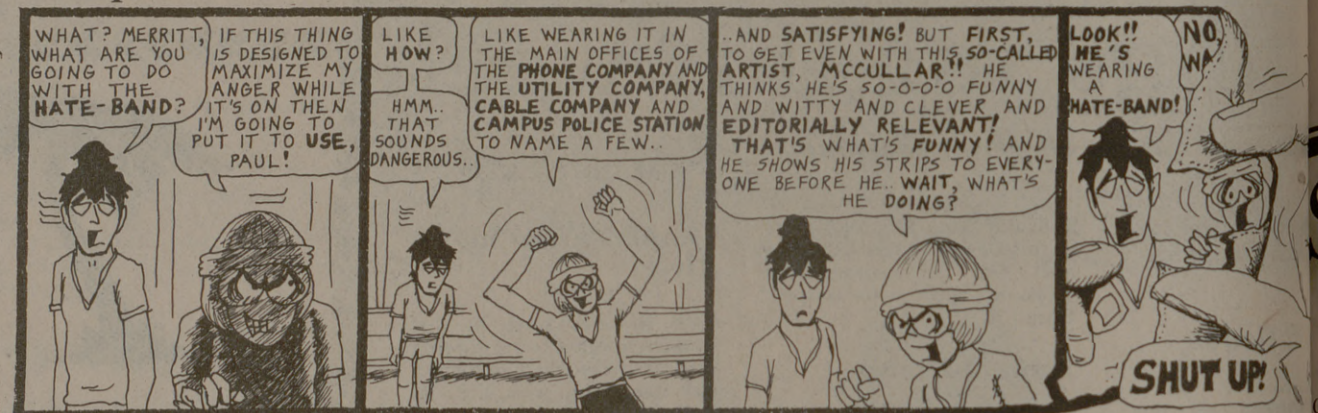

### Former inspector involved

## Nuclear coverup probed

United Press International DALLAS — The U.S. Atomic Safety and Licensing Board has asked the Texas attorney general's office to determine if inspectors were forced to cover up flaws at the controversial Comanche Peak nuclear power plant. The board made the request Tuesday during a telephone conference call, which included representatives of primary plant owner Texas Utilities Co., the staff of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and members of the Citizens Association for Sound Energy.

CASE is a Dallas-based group opposed to the plant. The Atomic Safety and Licensing Board has been gathering information since Dec. 1981 to make a recommendation to the NRC on whether the plant should be licensed to operate.

The attorney general's office will begin its investigation by interviewing witnesses questioned by the federal commission in an earlier case involving one-time inspector Charles Atchison. Licensing Board chairman Peter B. Bloch has indicated he needs more information on whether Atchison's case shows a pattern of intimidation of inspectors.

A former quality control inspector for Brown & Root the Comanche site, Atchison says he was fired in 1981. He found faulty welds on supports and filed reports of the poor workmanship.
