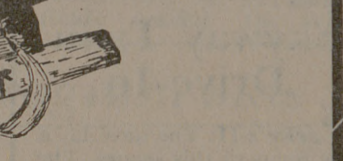

Prosecutor cuts loose 'hanging' psychiatrist

DALLAS — The District Attorney's office, generally disenchanted with psychiatrists, has decided to stop calling on Dr. James Grigson, the so-called "Hanging Shrink," whose testimony in capital murder cases has resulted in a number of death sentences.
Grigson, who earned \$75,000 last year as an expert witness for the county, testified for the defense in the drunk driving trial of Sheriff Don Byrd.
Byrd was acquitted last week after Grigson testified Byrd may

have suffered a mild stroke before his car hit a light post in April.
"I guess you could say that was the straw that broke the camel's back, when he started to testify on strokes," said District Attorney Henry Wade.
In an internal memo made public Tuesday, Wade told his staff: "Dr. Grigson will not be called as a witness for the state under any circumstances. This office will no longer vouch for (his) credibility."
Grigson is known for his testi-

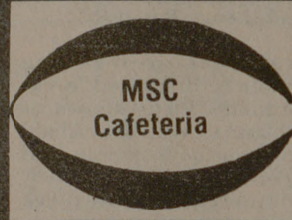
mony in the punishment of capital murder cases.
Grigson, whose support of the death penalty earned him the name "Doctor Doom" and the "Hanging Shrink," was the first 1981 U.S. Supreme Court case that set limits on psychiatric testimony in death penalty cases.
When told of the attorney's decision, Grigson said Wade was unaware he had been dealing with elderly patients which qualified him to testify out strokes.

Owner loses property, vows to open rent-free apartments

HOUSTON — An apartment complex owner who said God would provide for financial problems if he allowed homeless and disabled to live rent free lost his property in a mortgage foreclosure but vowed to open new rent-free apartments.
Walter Rode watched helplessly Tuesday as buildings which housed the Severne Apartments People Redeemer Spiritual Business Humanity in

Christ were auctioned to a real estate firm for \$525,000.
Rode, who had owned the southwest Houston apartment complex since 1976, said he rented some of the units to the homeless and disabled for free in accordance with "God's will," leaving him unable to meet financial obligations on the property.
He had predicted that God would prevent the foreclosure and auction, and would some-

how provide the \$525,000 needed to meet mortgage payments.
More than half of the paying tenants had moved out of the building after it was turned off last week of an \$8,300 unpaid Houston Lighting & Power bill.
A spokesman for the owner, Med Properties International, said the 64-unit apartment building will be sold and the remaining residents have to leave.
