Petroleum and agricultural products were not eligible under the low-interest loan program, but Padilla said there was no limit on the size of the transac-

Padilla said credit under the program could be initiated by the American importer going to his U.S. bank and obtaining a letter of credit to be confirmed in Mexico by BancoConfia.

Padilla said the program — Fondo para el Fomento de Productos Manufacturados — has been in operation since 1964 but has been ineffective in the past, partly because of the relatively high valuation of the Mexican




