**Landry will go with White**

DALLAS — The Dallas Cowboys have had a space-age image ever since they first began using computers in the 1960's, but only now has the team decided to get its own system.  
"They have always called us the cold, computerized Cowboys," said club president and general manager Tex Schramm. "I guess we just got colder."  
The team will use the system in all phases of its operation, including the storage and retrieval of the myriad of information kept on other teams and their

on-the-field habits.  
About half the teams in the National Football League currently have their own computer and a dozen other NFL clubs will be utilizing a system made by the same company selected by the Cowboys.  
So with brilliant teen-agers breaking into computers around the country these days, does Schramm fear any such incidents might take place with the Cowboys.  
"We have excellent security with our system," he said. "We have all the codes you would

want.  
"But even if somebody did break in, they wouldn't understand what they found. We don't put game plans in the computer. We put stuff from other teams in there."  
The Cowboys are spending their first full week in Dallas, having broken their training camp in Thousand Oaks, Calif.  
And as work progressed for the club's final exhibition game against the Houston Oilers Saturday night, coach Tom Landry made a series of observations:  
— Defensive end Harvey Martin, he said, was not playing up to his capabilities. "He needs to come on," said Landry. "You have to work harder when you are older. You have to work with more determination when you get past 30."  
— Rookie punter John Warren will come under close scrutiny during the final week of preseason to determine if the punting chores will be taken away from Danny White. "Out in camp," said Landry, "Warren was really booming them when I would see him each morning.

Maybe we should have had more games at 9 a.m."  
— White was the quarterback taken out of a ball game because he threw a few interceptions. "It isn't like a pitcher," said Landry. "Everybody has confidence in a quarterback in a game."  
The Cowboys will have the last of their preseason trimming rookie Darrell Songer, placing rookie Steve Johnson on the injured reserve list.

PITTSBURGH — They may still be 8½ games back, but the third-place Houston Astros figure their doubleheader sweep of the Pittsburgh Pirates Tuesday night put them right back in

the thick of the race for the National League Western Division championship.  
Meanwhile, in the East, the second-place Pirates managed to stay within a half game of first-place Philadelphia despite their 6-5 and 2-1 losses to Houston — Pittsburgh's fourth and fifth defeats in the last six games.
