## Movie attempts to frighten by using 'different' tricks

Horror films have taken a new dimension as of recently. This classic genre of films no longer claims to scare us by giving us the biggest and the most gory movie to date. Horror and fright have taken more approaches. Movies now try to scare us by playing tricks on our mind. A good 1983 horror film will leave the scariest part to your imagination and play off common fears. The latest movie to do so is Nightmares.

Nightmares is divided into four basic plots.

The writing also is trite. The stories were old and the outcomes were predictable. It was a story of action, and the actors were able to carry the pace of the story much better because of the limited dia-

The strengths of the film are limited. One of the biggest was that the movie tried to startle you by playing with your mind.
