# Man arrested, charged in death of Salvadorans

RICHMOND — The Mexican government has arrested and plans to prosecute a Mexican national indicted in Fort Bend County on charges of kidnapping and killing four Salvadorans, officials said Tuesday.

Arturo Martinez Herrera of Nuevo Laredo, Mexico, was arrested at his home over the weekend by Mexican officials on charges of aggravated kidnapping and capital murder in the July 1982 slaying of the Salvadorans, Fort Bend County Assistant District Attorney Don Bankston said.

Herrera, who is about 30 years old, is the alleged leader of an illegal alien smuggling ring, known as Los Tejas, that is believed to be responsible for smuggling the Salvadorans into Houston from Mexico, Bankston said.

Mexican officials decided to prosecute him in Mexico under a reciprocal agreement with the United States rather than have him returned to Fort Bend County for trial, Bankston said.

U.S. officials and the Fort Bend County District Attorney's office have been seeking Her-

rrera's arrest for more than a year.

The bodies of Jose Guzman, 25; Misiel Turcio, 17; Roman Turcios, 16; and Pablo Flores, age unknown, were found July 16, 1982, on the banks of the Brazos River, each man shot to death in the head and their hands bound.

Thirteen Mexican nationals were indicted in the deaths. Five of the Mexicans have been apprehended by authorities and the remaining men are still at large and believed to be in Mexico.

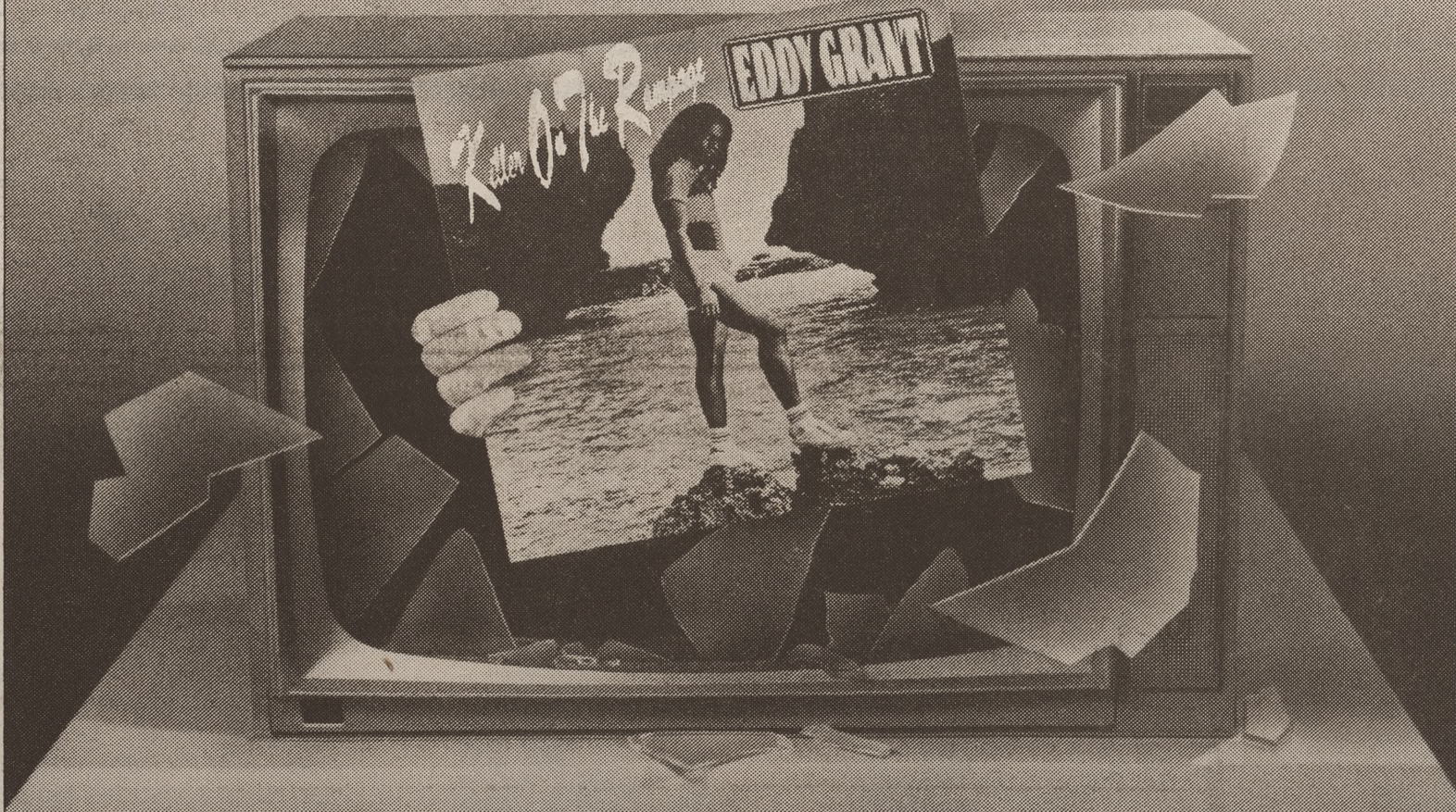
## Library Sidewalk

## Record series offered to kids

DALLAS — Stephen Star has a theory about music — and children.  
"Music is your memory's greatest tool," said Star, "and children absorb music like a sponge absorbs water."  
Star, a former commodities broker who hopes to play piper to the nation's children, was in Dallas recently promoting the first two albums in a planned series of 15 records designed for children aged 4 to 14.  
"Rainbow Rock" and "Rainbow Country" are the two musical vehicles that Star hopes to use in launching his entire "Rainbows and Stars" series of albums.  
The two albums of original songs written and produced by Star follow a format designed to enlighten as well as entertain.  
The song titles, ranging from "So Much to Learn" to "Land of Dreams" leave little doubt about the audience Star is trying to reach.  
The lyrics span topics from pet care to patriotism.  
"No one's done this," Star said. "I think I've got something special. A way to reach kids.  
"I got sick and tired of music performed by guys wearing dog collars with whips and chains being shoved down kids' throats about sex and drugs and violence," Star said.  
"I call my music real good feel good music."  
Star said his own childhood was marred by alcoholism and abuse, and his current enterprise gives him a shot at a "second childhood."  
But he said his primary goal taking on the music business is claims is turning young children into adult buyers.  
"The music industry has sugar-coated fluff for kids under five," Star said. "The kid listens one or two times and that's it and there's nothing else there."  
"They've created adult buyers out of 8- and 10-year olds."  
So Star created his musical alternative for kids, priced at \$5.98 per album.  
"This is my main goal, to get a kid singing," he said. "Get a kid singing my songs and what you're getting is turning negative peer pressure into positive peer influences."
