Bus driver hits brakes, safely stops hijacking

SIERRA BLANCA - A Greyhound bus driver suddenly braked the vehicle Tuesday to throw a knife-wielding hijacker off balance and end a 400-mile ride of terror through the De-sert Southwest, authorities said. U. S. Border Patrol agents
