Any student who fails the written examination (EPE) must satisfy the English Proficiency requirement designated by his/her respective department.

Kansas deputy to interview confessed murderer Lucas

United Press International TOPEKA — A Shawnee County sheriff's deputy will interview confessed mass killer Henry Lee Lucas as soon as Lucas' Texas murder trial is completed, officials said Tuesday.

A murder trial for Lucas in Denton, slated to begin Monday, was delayed until Nov. 7.

The Topeka Police Department suspects Lucas in four

slayings, while sheriff deputies are attempting to establish a link between the convicted murderer in two deaths, law enforcement officials said. One of the slayings is being investigated by both agencies.

Last week, about 100 lawmen converged on Monroe, La., for a briefing on Lucas, 47, and Otis Elwood Toole, 36, a former traveling companion of Lucas'. Maj. Bob Inman and Lt. Tom Sargent, both of the Shawnee

County Sheriff's Department, were at the briefing.

Police Lt. Larry Lemon said police were investigating Lucas in connection with the 1978 death of Shirley Rose Steiner, whose body was found near I-70. He declined to elaborate on three other deaths that he said investigators hoped to question Lucas about.

Lucas claims he has killed more than 150 women in 17 states since 1975.

Besides Steiner, Inman, the sheriff's department with the 1976 death of Ocobock.

He said a police detective in Jacksonville, Fla., would view Toole for sheriff's deputies. Toole is in jail in Jacksonville for an arson conviction.

He said Lucas would admit to every killing he's confronted with. He said he has baited Lucas in the past to see if he was merely a
