

Debakey testifies to help Baylor program

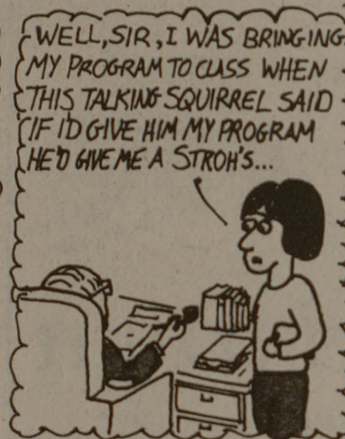

HOUSTON — Heart surgeon Michael DeBakey has testified in court in defense of a Baylor College of Medicine program that sends surgeons to Saudi Arabia.

red from participating in the program. Saudi Arabia bans anything associated with Israel, including persons of the Jewish faith, but Baylor denies any discrimination. Federal law forbids cooperating with the Arab boycott against Israel. The suit was filed by Dr. Stuart Linde, 40, now a Baylor

professor, and Lawrence Abrams, 37, a New York anesthesiologist who formerly worked with Baylor. DeBakey, 75, said in court Tuesday that if he believed the program discriminated against Jewish physicians he would cancel it. "The only discrimination we make concerns competence," he said.

Linde and Abrams claim they were illegally and arbitrarily denied the handsome salary and benefits received by members of a Baylor cardiovascular team who took three-month rotations at a Saudi Arabia hospital.

Truck kills roller skaters

WEATHERFORD — Two Michigan brothers died Wednesday in an accident while

roller skating cross-country in a promotion for Mattel Inc. Daniel Helwig, 24, and his brother David, 28, were killed in an accident on Interstate 20 near Weatherford, about 20 miles west of Fort Worth.

The accident occurred at 12:46 a.m., when a semi-trailer rig, driven by Weldon Gene Garrett of Arlington, struck the motor home where Daniel Helwig was riding, Department of Public Safety officials said. The motor home hit David, who was skating by the side of the road, DPS troopers said.

"The motor home was moving behind the skater," DPS spokesman David Wells said. "The truck came over the crest of the hill and saw the motor home straddling the strip between the outside lane and the shoulder. The skater was actually traveling in the lane. The

trucker tried to swerve to the left to avoid striking (the motor home), then lost control."

Trooper J.C. Garza said the motor home was traveling about 10 mph when it was hit. The im-

Spencer Boise, a spokesman for Mattel Inc. in Los Angeles, said the brothers were skating to

promote a doll the Mattel division is introducing for Christmas.

"It was a promotion with Baby Skates, a new doll which is on roller skates in Boise said.

Susan Clويد, a spokeswoman for Roller Skating Association in Nebraska, said the brothers wanted to promote the skating and make the Guinness Book of World Records. "The skaters had training and knew how to skate," she said. "Up until now, it has been well ahead of skating on the road. That's why we understand why they were in at midnight."

The DPS had been talking about the skaters three days ago, Clويد said.

The brothers left Weatherford Sept. 19 and were in Los Angeles in early December. Bill Helwig, 27, and Lietha, 19, a family friend, was driving the motor home when the accident occurred. They were uninjured.

Opal Helwig, the mother, said the van was lit with rotating beacons.

"They were young and had great faith, you might say they were active in our church."

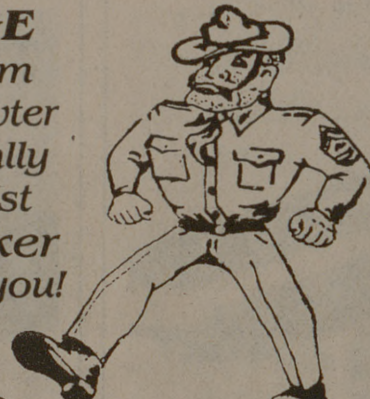

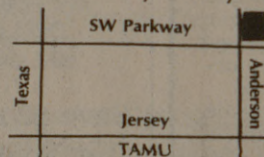
