"I expected it," Lucas said as he was led away following District Judge W.C.Boyd's formal Th

Lucas told reporters he would plead guilty to the eight remaining murder charges against him.

'I will ask for death," he said. The one-eyed former mental patient said the murder conviction Wednesday was "just what I Punishment deliberations expected" in his first trial since he began telling authorities he killed more than 150 women in 17 states during the past eight

In his presentation Wednesday, District Attorney Jerry Cobb urged the jury to "have the guts" to send Lucas to jail for life for Powell's murder.


