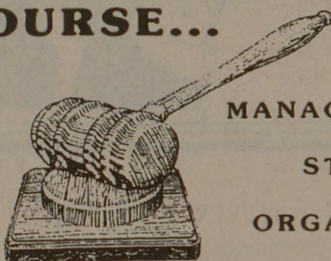

COURSE OBJECTIVES

#### COURSE CONTENT

The content and organization of the seminar will emphasize practical application rather than theoretical concepts. Instruction will cover such topics as:

- Principles of leadership
- Goal setting
- Communication skills
- Motivating student members/volunteers
- Running a meeting effectively
- Publicity and public relations techniques

The seminar has been carefully designed to provide an overall picture of operation of a student organization. In addition to a survey of the management principles involved, students will gain functional knowledge of the various activities involved in successfully leading a student group. The class setting will also provide students with the opportunity to interact with fellow students and professional staff on a routine basis.

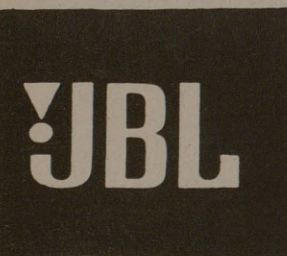
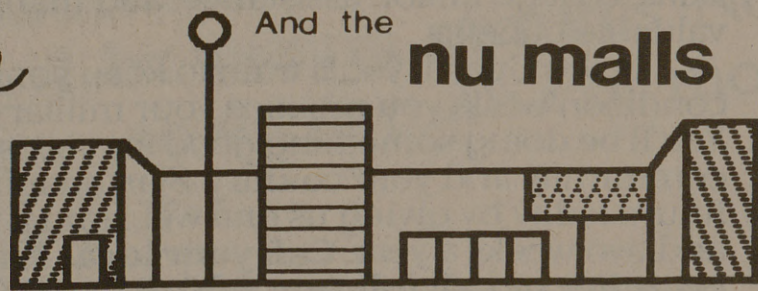

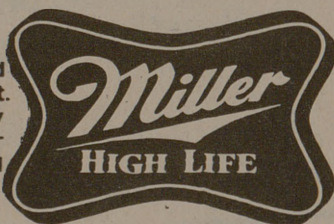

## Vote-buying suits settled

LEESVILLE, La. — Out-of-court settlements have been reached in libel suits against a Shreveport television station and newspapers in Dallas and Shreveport, La., involving vote-buying allegations.

Under the agreement, parties in the suits were prohibited from revealing monetary amounts of the settlements.

The suits were filed over a

series of reports and articles during the 1978 vote-buying trials of then-Rep. Claude "Buddy" Leach, D-La., Vernon Parish District Attorney Bill Tilley and Assistant District Attorney Edwin Cabra.

The men were acquitted on charges they helped Leach buy more than 1,000 votes for his 1978 congressional race. More than 30 other people in Leesville, Leach's home town, and in

other areas of his congressional district pleaded guilty to being convicted of vote buying.

Tilley sued the Star Journal and its then-editor Bill Keith and KSLA-TV reporter Mike Stagg. Cabra, the Dallas Morning News, sued the Dallas Morning News, publishing a series of articles and a book that maligned Leach and was based on half-truths.
