

December candidates approved

Faculty consider new major

The Faculty Senate Monday evening approved nearly 3,000 candidates for graduation in December and voted in favor of establishing a speech communi-

cation department at Texas A&M.

The graduate and undergraduate students approved by the Senate will receive their degrees Dec. 9 and 10 if they complete all requirements for graduation. The Senate's action marks

the first time since it was established in May that the Senate has approved a curriculum issue. In the past, graduation candidates were passed by the now defunct Academic Council.

The areas of speech communication and theatre arts, currently part of the Department of English, will be combined into one department in the College of Liberal Arts if the proposal is also approved by university administration officials and the Coordinating Board Texas College and University System.

The Coordinating Board has final say on the matter.

The proposed degree — the Bachelor of Arts Degree in Speech Communication and Provisional Certification for Secondary Teachers — will focus on the study of spoken language as part of a liberal education. The B.A. degree will be offered by the College of Liberal Arts and the teacher certification option will be offered jointly with the College of Education.

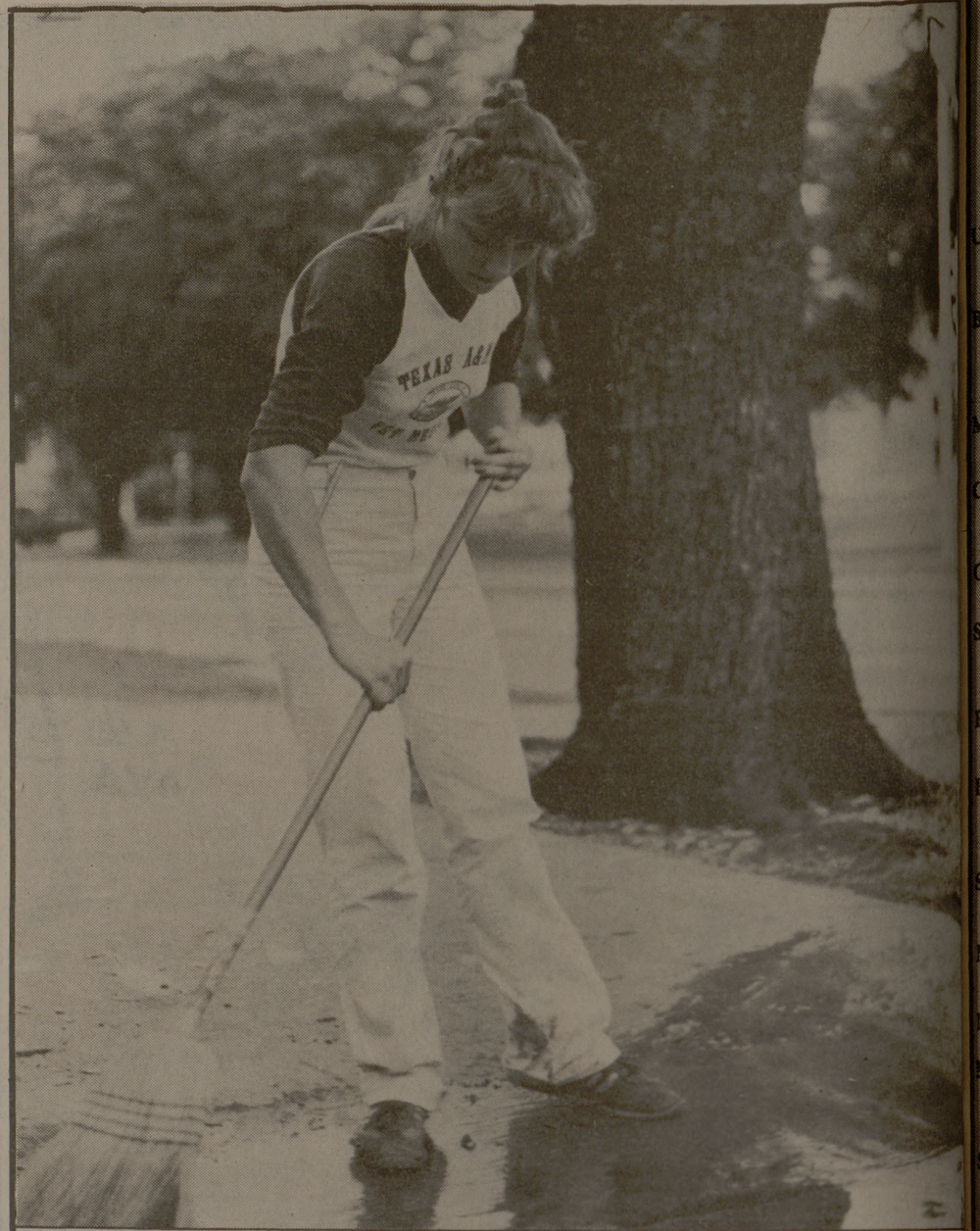

Flood dams prevented \$9 million of damage

TULSA, Okla. — U.S. Army Corps of Engineers flood control dams prevented more than

\$9 million in flood damage last month in Oklahoma and Texas, officials said Monday. Tulsa District Engineer Co.

Franklin T. Tilton said in Red River Basin, Waurika on Beaver Creek prevented some \$8 million in damaging flooding Oct. 17 through Oct. 21.

Denison Dam on the Red River prevented \$1 million in damages, Tilton said, and La Kemp on the Wichita River prevented an estimated \$100,000 in damages.

The unfinished Arcadia Dam on the Deep Fork River in Edmond prevented about \$740,000 in damages in Arkansas River Basin, Tilton said.
