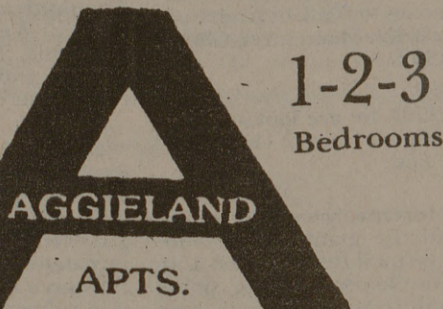

Crash victims win lawsuit

United Press International DENVER — Four Texans who survived a 1981 plane crash that killed a fifth man have won \$375,000 in an out-of-court settlement of lawsuits filed against the firm that leased the aircraft.

The plane was flying at 16,000 feet, without oxygen, shortly before it crashed. Meeks died while trying to seek help in a snowstorm.

Girl's body rejects organ

3-year-old still in coma

United Press International SHREVEPORT, La. — A 3-year-old girl who received a liver transplant this summer remained in a coma Sunday brought on by intestinal bleed-

ing when the transplanted organ ceased to function normally, physicians said.

Veronica Rice was listed in serious condition in the Inten-

sive Care Unit of the Louisiana State University Medical Center. "Her vital signs have stabilized, but otherwise her condition remains unchanged," said Elaine King, hospital spokeswoman.

The youngster, who had been listed in good condition since her transplant on July 29, slipped into a coma Saturday morning and was listed in critical condition for 24 hours, hospital officials said.

The daughter of Ray and Elaine Rice of Shreveport was the first liver transplant patient at the medical center.

Her condition since the 10-hour operation had been improving and doctors were optimistic about her future.

Asked what her chances of survival were, Dr. Michael Rohr said, "There's not really any way of determining that. The number of liver transplant patients surviving five years can be

counted on one hand. The percent live up to two years. Another physician, Dr. McDonald, said the child's condition could be endangering her metabolism of the transplanted liver.

When an infection develops at the site of the incision during the operation, physicians last month determined the liver was not functioning normally.

"Bleeding in the intestines commonly produces coma in patients with liver functions," Ms. King said. "This emphasizes the deterioration which has occurred in liver functions in the past two to four weeks."

Doctors have returned the child's name to the national organ sharing network as a candidate for a new liver.

Unbending juror forces mistrial

United Press International MONTGOMERY, Ala. — A mistrial was declared Sunday in the trial of a black man accused of trying to kill two white police officers.

The mistrial was declared after the jury — which had deliberated for 20 hours over three days — announced for the second time that it was hopelessly deadlocked.

The defendant, Worrie

Taylor of Warren, Okla., staring straight into the jury as the foreman announced the panel could not reach a verdict. The announcement, no visible reaction from Taylor or the predominantly black courtroom crowd of about 100 people.

Montgomery County Judge Randall Thomas cautioned the audience that the mistrial might lead to a confrontation between black and white courtroom spectators.

The jury of eight whites and four blacks was ordered to start a third day of deliberations after a black juror who suffered an apparent asthma attack Saturday was examined by doctors and found fit to resume duty.

The jury reported on Sunday that it was hopelessly deadlocked, but Thomas refused to declare a mistrial and asked for continued deliberations.

After about two hours of deliberations Sunday the judge asked that a mistrial be declared. Thomas took the motion for advice. The jury reported its continued deadlock two hours later.

Taylor, 49, was charged with attempted murder in the attack on officers Les Bledsoe and Eddie Spivey.

The plainclothes officers were beaten and shot after being another defendant's home occupied by Taylor and other mourners who had returned from a funeral.

The jury had been given the option of finding Taylor innocent, guilty of attempted murder or guilty of a less serious charge of third-degree assault misdemeanor.
