**Texas' educators blasted**

**NEW YORK** — Time Inc.'s science magazine "Discover" blasted the Texas Board of Education for "know-nothing" public school textbook guidelines on subjects such as evolution that it said distort scientific learning nationwide. The attack appeared in an unsigned editorial in the magazine's January edition. The magazine was released to news media Wednesday.

"Publishers take the Texas guidelines seriously; the state is the single largest textbook buyer," the editorial said. "Weak-willed publishers therefore tailor all their textbooks to curry favor with the Texas board of education."

Education board members authorized to comment could not be contacted. The magazine referred to November hearings at which the board affirmed guidelines requiring that textbooks accepted in the state identify evolution as "theory rather than fact" and that it should be taught as "one of several explanations of the origin of humankind."

As an example of the guidelines the editorial said "deprived" children nationwide, it cited deletion of the word "evolution" from the sole high school text published by one division of Doubleday.

The editorial also cited examples from Holt, Rinehart & Winston and Silver Burdett texts that contained drastic deletions of material about evolution. However, the editorial commented Texans who testified at the November hearings against the guidelines, quoting Nobel laureate Steven Weinberg of the University of Texas, who urged that publishers ignore sales to Texas "until we have come to our senses."

**SAN ANTONIO** — A tractor-trailer rig Wednesday knocked a car off an Interstate 10 overpass onto the busy lanes of Loop 410, but the driver and her 3-year-old daughter survived, police said. Officer Stephen Tucker said Kathleen Markham, 34, of New Braunfels, was in stable condition at Medical Center hospital with head injuries. Her daughter, 3-year-old Alyssa, was treated and released. Mrs. Markham was expected to survive, Tucker said. He said a tractor-trailer attempting to change lanes across a bridge guardrail on Interstate 10 in northwest San Antonio and the car fell onto the 410 freeway below.

**NEW YORK** — If a list on your Christmas shopping make sure the one you buy Consumer Product Safety Commission certification attests to a safety expert. The certification means manufacturer has met the government's standards of strength and safety, says director of F.W. Woolworth Quality Assurance Laboratory Dan Turcott's other tip recognizing safe toys includes — Stuffed animals' eyes, noses should be secured, pinned to the head. If a child pulls them off, the child may pop them into his mouth. — Seams should be properly sewn. If they rip open, the child may eat the stuffing. — Before buying any especially metal or plastic toys, check for sharp edges or points that could seriously injure a child. Turcott says all toy stores and company's stores meet CPSC requirements.
