## Health officials continue seeking typhoid source

officials said Wednesday they were not ready to abandon the search for the source of a typhoid outbreak that struck nine people, including eight

Trinity University students.
Dr. Courand Rothe, director of the Metropolitan Health District, said investigators are still looking for the source of the disease although the outbreak appeared to be over.

The ninth victim was confirmed to have the case this weekend, but no new cases have

been reported, he said.
All but one of the nine victims are students at Trinity University, but health officials said the other victim often ate at the campus cafeteria. Up to 200 stool and blood

samples have been taken from Trinity food service employees and workers at nearby res-


