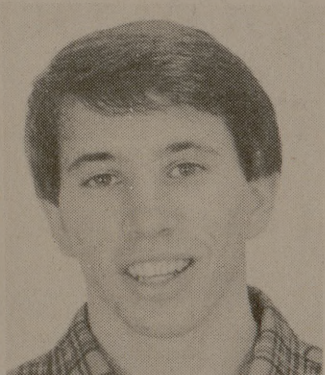
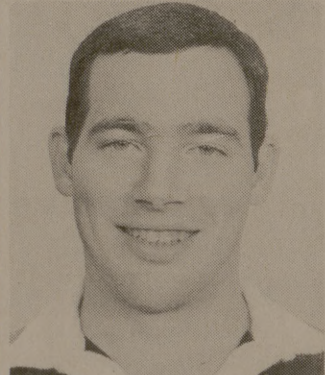
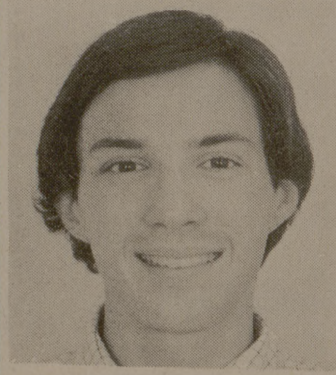

**Baseball:
More teams
in 1986?**

INDIANAPOLIS — Major league baseball's winter meetings ended with word that the league might expand in 1986. The Indiana Baseball Committee leaked word that the league could announce up to six new franchises next winter, including one in Indianapolis and another in San Antonio. Two teams will be added to the American League and four will be added to the National League — giving each a total of 16 teams, Committee Chairman Danny Danielson said Tuesday. The nine-member expansion committee consists of Commissioner Bowie Kuhn, the presidents of the National League and American League, and three owners from each league. Danielson said preliminary proposals for expansion could be ready by the summer baseball meetings, with a final vote on expansion to take place at the 1984 winter meetings. Expansion approval would require a three-fourths vote of the league and a majority vote from the other league. Danielson said his understanding was that any teams created next winter would begin playing in 1986. He also indicated some cities might be announced as new expansion franchises before others. Cities other than Indianapolis and San Antonio seeking major league baseball include Miami, Tampa and St. Petersburg, Fla.; Denver; Buffalo, N.Y.; Vancouver, Canada; New Orleans; Honolulu; Washington, D.C.; Nashville, Tenn., and Brooklyn, N.Y.
