A&M grad wins first place award

Texan victim of auto death

EUFUALA, Okla. — A Texas woman getting out of a stalled car was struck and killed and four other people were injured on an icy bridge by a second auto that skidded into them, an Oklahoma Highway Patrol spokesman said Monday.

The victim, Gracie Mae Elder, 73, of Carrollton, died at

Eufaula Hospital about four hours after the accident, which occurred about 6:15 p.m. Sunday on the U.S. 69 South Canadian River bridge in McIntosh County.

Troopers say the accident occurred as the victim, the driver and three other passengers were trying to get out of a car that had spun out of control on the icy bridge and stopped across the northbound lanes.

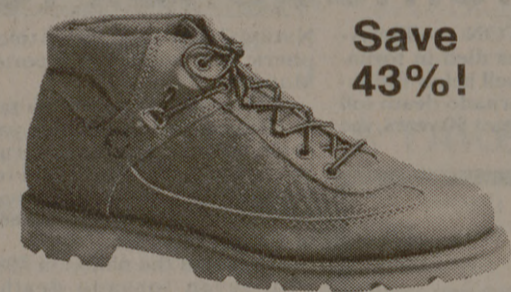

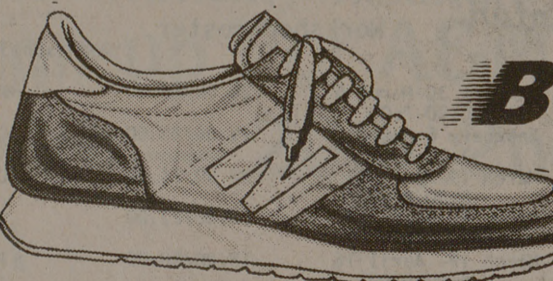
