Beer posters to stay at Baylor University

WACO — Baylor University students who took beer posters and Playboy Playmates off their dormitory room walls can put them back up because of a ruling from school president Herbert Reynolds.

Reynolds said a ban on beer posters and photographs of nude or scantily-clad women in men's dorm rooms was imposed without his knowledge.

"It was not reviewed by me and I was unaware of it," he said. "I first read about it in the student newspaper."

The policy apparently enacted by several administrators at the Baptist university long known for its strict policies against what are considered moral influences.

"When we got back from Christmas break, we had a meeting and were told that policy against the posters being enforced," said sophomore Mike Murphy. "I mine down, but I don't understand it."

Reynolds apparently agreed there's a world of difference between our current student health and safety, as alcohol consumption is concerned, and what they were put up in their room. Reynolds said. "They're putting posters up since I'm a young person."
