WASHINGTON — A new drug undergoing testing at medical centers around the country may prevent eye problems which afflict nearly half of the nation's diabetics, researchers said Wednesday.

Sorbitol has no known role in the body, according to researchers from Ayerst Laboratories, which began clinical trials of its own version of sorbitol about two years ago and has said early results from the trial are encouraging.
