Eurythmics Touch RCA ★★★★

In case you were worrying, Annie and Dave Lennox have successfully beaten the sophomore jinx with their new album. In fact, they haven't just equaled *Sweet Dreams*, they've improved upon it.

Touch shows the couple in a much more diverse light but they're still using electronic drums too much and the songs are sometimes a bit "noisy," but the tunes are much better this time around. The entire first side is filled with danceable or listenable ballads (just ask my suitmates, they play it constantly).

"Here Comes the Rain Again" is the first single, with a big boost from its heavy rotation on MTV. Although the beat remains slow, the tempo keeps a tense feeling that perfectly suits Annie's voice. Some rock

critics have started calling her the best female singer in rock, which is a big overstatement, but as long as attitude counts

for more than expression she may keep them fooled.

This album really gets moving on some of the more up-tempo cuts like "Right by Your Side." The mixture of the heavy new wave sound with a calypso background provides a chance for a little more light-hearted music, a nice break from the usual mood.

The Eurythmics have kept most of the same topics from their last album — love, passion and the overall lack of both. One of the best examples from this set is "No Fear, No Hate, No Pain," in which Annie has some octave jumps that you will either hate or love. Whatever the outcome, you know this girl is taking big chances putting them on a pop album.

With the more consistent song-writing, Eurythmics receive the distinct honor of performing an album better than their debut. If Annie and Dave can remove a little bit more of the noise and replace it with music we may be seeing them around for a long time. Las Vegas is still a few years away, but ...

Best Single of the Week — The new Thomas Dolby cut edged out Queen with his brand new release, "Hyperactivity."

KTAW is playing it, although the white funk beat doesn't mix that readily with their programming. The realism of the trombone solo that Dolby gets out of his wave synthesizer is amazing. The single today is available on a "domestic 12" and the album will be released in a few weeks.
