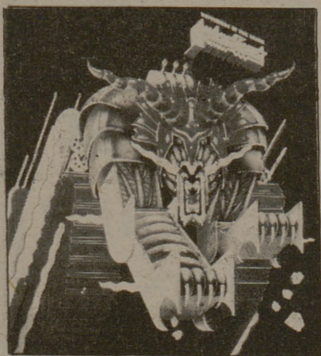

Judas Priest Defenders of the Faith CBS

The worst part of this album is the incipid "Mettalion" drawing on the cover. The Priest would have done a lot better if they could have taken a hint from Led Zeppelin and just use a plain brown wrapper. Once you start listening, I would advise doing something evil with it, like burning it.

The music here is typical for "the world's best heavy metal band" — stabbing guitar and vocal lines with mindless, banal lyrics. But they just do it so well. Only one problem continually crops up on this album — some of the songs just go too fast for the vocals to keep up. The first cut, "Freewheel Burning," is like that, but after it things clear up.

"Jawbreaker" is more in line with a driving thump reminiscent of *Screaming for Vengeance*. The first song to stand out of the crowd is "The Sentinel" which breaks down in the middle for a short synthesized warning from front man Rob Halford. As soon as the mood is created, it's time to get moving with more guitars. It's good to

hear the band adding some texture to the usual pounding, if only for a minute. The split leads by Glenn Tipton and K.K. Downing are a nice touch, especially when they ease into harmony.

On the second side the innocent head-banging listener finds out not only that "Love Bi-

tes," but also that "Some Heads Are Going To Roll." As I said at the beginning, it's really mindless stuff, but if that's all you need, Priest is still kicking out the best.
