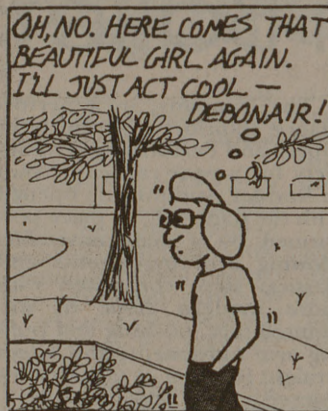

Strong economy seen for Texas

EL PASO — A leading Texas banker Tuesday predicted healthy growth for Texas in 1984-85.

"Our economy in Texas is

strong," Gene Bishop, chairman of the board of Mercantile Southwest Corp., one of the state's largest bank holding companies, said. "Prime interest rates will probably go down in 1985-86, depending on what happens to the deficit.

"It was a tough year for Texas, with a number of banks feeling the pressure of the peso devaluations, problems in the oil industry and in agriculture, but we (Mercantile) still earned more than \$100 million.

"In all three areas, there has been progress. The problems have bottomed out and the economy is beginning to turn around in Texas." Mercantile, he said, was not

hurt by lower oil prices and other problems in the industry because the member banks had only 13 percent involvement in oil-related loans.

"A disruption of the flow of oil from the Middle East would not necessarily benefit the rest of the country but would definitely help Texas," he said. "Any increase in the price of oil would mean additional drilling in the state."

The prime interest rate will probably be higher than 11.5 percent by the end of the year as the federal government struggles to control a \$185 billion deficit, Bishop said.

The increase in interest rates will continue until Congress

and the administration succeed in cutting the federal deficit, he said.

The strong economy nationwide brought about the increase in the prime rate Monday from 11 percent to 11.5 percent, he said.

He predicted Mexico and other foreign countries would have difficulty repaying debts as the increase in effect over long period.

Bishop described debate over reducing the federal deficit as rhetoric on the part of both the Reagan administration and Congress.

"But the deficit will have to come down, and when that happens the interest rates will come down," he said.
