# Mother faces chair or life for killing paralyzed son

MILTON, Fla. — Judi Buenoano, convicted of killing her paralyzed son to collect insurance money and considered a suspect in the deaths of her two husbands, will be sentenced Monday to the electric chair or life imprisonment.

Buenoano, 40, a mother of three from Gulf Breeze, is to be sentenced at 10 a.m. EST by Circuit Judge George Lowrey.

A 12-member jury in the Florida Panhandle town found Buenoano guilty Saturday of murdering her son Michael Goodyear, 19, by taking him on a canoe trip in May 1980 and dumping him overboard wearing metal leg braces and no life jacket.

Hours before, while the jury

was deliberating her fate, she and her other son, James Goodyear, 18, were arrested on charges of attempted murder and insurance fraud for allegedly planting a bomb last summer in a car owned by her fiancé, James Gentry, in Pensacola, Fla.

A spokesman for the U.S. Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms in Pensacola said evidence indicated Buenoano and James concocted a scheme to kill Gentry and collect \$530,000 in life insurance.

Buenoano also is suspected in the deaths of her husband in Orlando, Fla., in 1971 and her common-law husband in Trinidad, Colo., in 1978. In each case, she was beneficiary on life

insurance policies taken out on the men.

Buenoano, described by the prosecutor as a "black widow that fed on her young," also was convicted Saturday of grand larceny for bilking several life insurance companies who wrote policies on Michael's life. The prosecution said she began making lavish purchases with the "blood money" just days after Michael died.

Lowrey could sentence her to Florida's electric chair or life imprisonment. With a life term under state law, she would not be eligible for parole until she served 25 years.

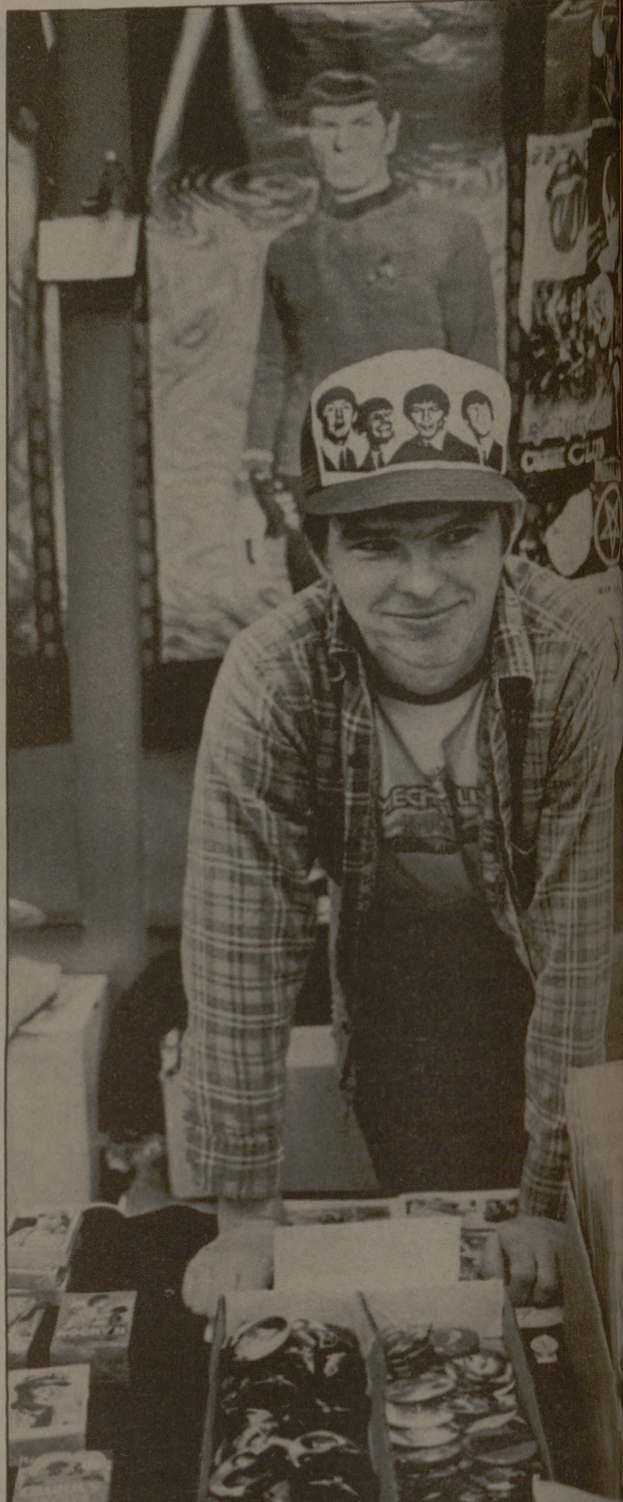

### Americans are smoking billions fewer cigarettes

DAYTONA BEACH, Fla. — Americans are smoking billions fewer cigarettes and the rate of increase in lung cancer deaths for men has slightly slowed, the president of the American Cancer Society said Sunday.

Dr. Gerald Murphy, who is also director of the Roswell Park Memorial Institute in Buffalo, N.Y., said per capita consumption of cigarettes dropped 7 percent in 1983, the "largest drop ever recorded in a single year."

"It represented a decline of 31 billion cigarettes smoked during a 12-month period—average drop of more than a billion cigarettes a month," said Murphy.

A Gallup poll commissioned by the society confirmed government figures that the number of smokers in the United States was shrinking, showing that in 1983 there were 10 percent fewer adults who said they had ever smoked than there were in 1980.

"An accelerating trend from the use of cigarettes is unmistakable," Murphy said in remarks to an American Cancer Society science writers seminar. "Clearly, it's no longer considered 'smart' to smoke."

Murphy said as cigarette consumption drops, the "death toll for all cigarette-related diseases will also decline."

He said the death rate from lung cancer among men age 25 to 44 has already dropped 25.3 per 100,000 in 1979, the latest year for which figures were available. In 1974, the rate was 29.5.

"Overall, the death rate from cancer of the lung continues to rise among men, but at a slower rate than in the past," he said.

Lung cancer deaths among women continue to rise, however, and the society has predicted it will overtake breast cancer as the No. 1 cancer killer of women. It has done so already in California, Florida, Kentucky, Washington, Virginia, Texas, Vermont, Nevada, Alaska and Hawaii.
