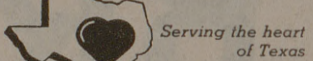

Sherrill trying to fill holes

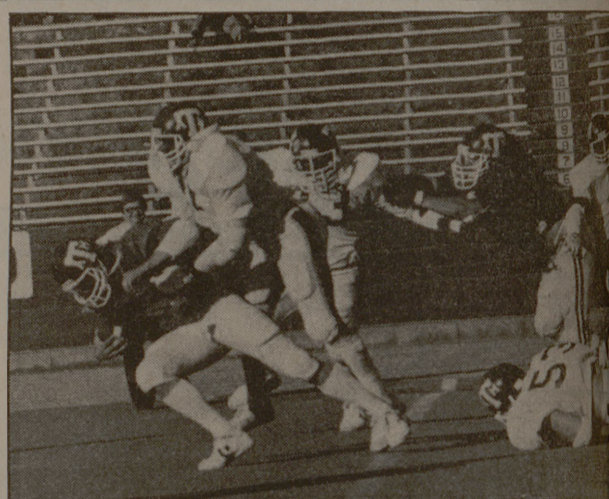
Texas A&M head football coach Jackie Sherrill may be considering buying space in the classified section of the newspaper. If so, it would probably say, "Wanted: A few good men to fill linebacker and nose guard positions. Apply in person at Kyle Field - experience helpful."

While things may never get that drastic, filling those positions is a dark cloud that has been looming over Sherrill's head since the Sunday morning after the A&M-Texas game.

After the Aggies' weekly scrimmage on Thursday, that was still the most persistent thought on Sherrill's mind.

"The best move we've made," he said, "is moving Johnny Holland to linebacker. We still need to find a nose guard and inside linebackers."

Holland, who will be a sophomore next fall, was recruited as a quarterback before being moved to defensive back.



The Aggies lost five linebackers this year, four of which were starters in 1983. That group accounted for 32 percent of all the Aggies' tackles last season.

Another dilemma Sherrill is faced with is injuries. Granted football is a sport where injuries are a fairly common occurrence but when they cut into a coach's starting lineup, that's when things get serious.

"We've got seven starters on the sideline right now that need to work," Sherrill said. "They will be gone for the rest of the spring."

Among the injured starters are defensive lineman Rod Sandler and offensive linemen Nate Steadman and Matt Dar-

win, a second-team all-conference center last season.

But in spite of injuries and shortage in the linebacker unit, Sherrill should still have a lot to be happy about. As there was only one word that could bring a smile to his face that word would probably be "quarterback."

"I wish all of our players were as good as quarterback Sherrill said.

In Thursday's scrimmage starter Kevin Murray hit 26 passes for 238 yards and a touchdown. Freshman receiver Craig Stump and Jay Hester also performing well.

Ag women lose to No.1 Titans

"I'm real happy with the way Shawn pitched against the No. 1 team," Brock said. "But I think she showed a little of her freshman blood out there. She lost some of her speed a few times."

The Aggies started the scoring in the second inning. Gaye McNutt doubled, scoring Josie Carter, who had singled and stolen second base.

Beffuddled by a slow motion

change-up, those two hits and all the offense A&M could muster.

The Titan bats got to work in the fourth inning and scored a run. Cal. State Fullerton again in the fifth and once again in the sixth with a home run.

Even though the loss hurt right before the tournament, Brock said it wasn't going to bother the team.

"After the game, the team was already talking about how they were going to beat the Titans tomorrow," Brock said.
