"I want to make it more contemporary, to get the universal message of the play," she says, "so it won't have a period set or costumes, but period acting in-

ity of videos by monthly audience and retail market polls. New videotapes are first put into a light rotation schedule, then are shown more or less often depending on record sales and audience response.

Controversy aside, the statistics prove that MTV is here to stay. A February 1983 Neilsen poll of people aged 12 to 34 who had watched the channel found that these viewers, who represented 83 percent of an audience estimated at 14 million, watched the channel for at least an hour each day for an average four and a half days a week. They watched the channel for about an hour and a half a day on weekends. Predictably, the young viewers are MTV's greatest support.

MTV also has won numerous awards, including several of the prestigious CLIO awards for advertising.

Many issues, such as censorship and the long-term consequences of watching

MTV, seem to be ignored by channel officials; at least they won't discuss them. Nonetheless, MTV is the first cable channel to explore the frontier of rock video. Judged at first as a

fleeting musical trend, rock 'n roll hung on with surprising tenacity, and MTV seems bound to prove its detractors wrong by doing the same.
