members discovered them. Dead are Danny Cruz, 5, and his cousins, Mark Cruz, 3, and

Raul Cruz, 4. The tragedy was discovered Saturday afternoon at Chapar-N.M., on the northeast boundary of El Paso, after the children had been missing for

about an hour. Laura Cruz, Danny's sister, said her father, Ismael Cruz, had purchased the old, chesttype freezer two weeks ago with the intention of repairing and using it. It was sitting about 30 yards behind the home, she

She said Danny and his cousins had been playing outdoors for about an hour but family members lost sight of them.

'We remembered the freezer and found them there," said Miss Cruz. Mark and Raul were sons of
