Airline asks for ticket extension

HOUSTON — Continental Airlines asked a federal bankruptcy court Tuesday to extend the period people can use or obtain credit on tickets purchased before the company filed for reorganization last fall.
The company had originally set a deadline of March 15 for seeking credit on the tickets and May 31 for using the tickets purchased before the airline filed for bankruptcy.
Continental asked the court to grant a six-month extension for both deadlines.
Attorney General Jim Mattox said the extension was sought after his office received complaints against Continental last fall.
Though agreeing to the terms of the extension, Continental officials said they did not admit violating the state's consumer protection law.
If the bankruptcy court approves the request, Mattox and Continental will file a similar assurance in a Harris County state district court.

Search ends for 3 men

GALVESTON — The Coast Guard Tuesday planned to end its search at nightfall for three men missing in the Gulf of Mexico since Sunday.
The men — Aramis Fernandez, George Nunez and Chuck Murray, all of Houston and all 22 — have been the target of an air and sea search during daylight since Sunday afternoon, when crew members on a work boat spotted their overturned 17-foot fishing boat 30 miles out in the Gulf from Freeport.
The three left on a fishing trip Saturday morning and did not return, relatives said.

Truck crushes man at construction site

AUSTIN — A runaway dump truck careened down an embankment in west Austin Tuesday and crashed into highway construction site, killing one man and injuring others.
Police identified the man as Edward Lee Simmons, 44, of Austin.
Witnesses said the accident happened around 10:30 a.m. when a dump truck hauling full load down a steep hill out of control.
The driver of the truck, aged to jump to safety after engine died, but the truck continued some 100 feet down hill until it smashed into a where the three men were working.
Simmons was killed instantly when he was pinned between the truck and the wall.
The accident site is just off scenic Loop 360 where a private construction company working on a roadway extension.
