## Witnesses testify against De Lorean A

LOS ANGELES - John De Lorean, desperate to regain control of De Lorean Motor Co. and its exotic gull-winged sports car, gladly made a pact with un-dercover federal agents to pump narcotics money into the ailing firm, witnesses testified Thursday.

De Lorean's enthusiasm was so great that he discussed a long-term drug trafficking compact that would begin after he wrested his Northern Ireland car company from receiv-

ership, witnesses testified.

FBI agent Benedict Tisa, who posed as a corrupt banker willing to handle money generated by multimillion-dollar drug transactions, testified that during his investigation of De Lorean the auto maker agreed to accept \$50 million from a major drug trafficker and launder it through his auto com-

With that done, Tisa testified, De Lorean planned to go into the drug business himself in partnership with yet another underworld figure who — unknown to De Lorean — had become an FBI informant.


