Juan de la Garza won the jav-elin with a throw of 251-10 and Arturo Barrios won the 5000meter run in a time of 14:30.10. Chappelle Henderson hurdled to a new team mark and second place in the 400-meter hurdles while Kurt Thome was second in the triple jump at 47-5.
