Garland wives charged with ordering murders

United Press International GARLAND — Two sisters were charged Wednesday with solicitation of capital murder for giving \$1,100 to an undercover officer as a down payment to kill their husbands, from whom they expected to collect \$225,000 in insurance, police said Wednesday.

They were arrested Tuesday afternoon in an east Dallas parking lot on charges they paid \$1,100 to a police officer posing as a hit man. Mrs. Scrivano offered \$5,000 to have her husband killed, police said, and Mrs. Bancker offered \$10,000 to have her husband slain.

Dorothy Scrivano, 53, and LaWayne Bancker 45, who work together and share a house with Mrs. Scrivano's husband in the Dallas suburb, were formally charged Wednesday and held in the Dallas County jail in lieu of \$25,000 bond each.

Lt. W.R. Patterson said they agreed to pay the balance after collecting on their husbands' insurance policies. "The women wanted their husbands killed as soon as possible," said Dallas police Sgt. Dan Asbill. "They didn't care how."

Mrs. Bancker was from her husband, Bancker, 64, a disabled Force retiree who lives in Antonio. Relatives said Bancker had been in the Scrivanos for months.

Two Texarkana deaths possible murder-suicide

United Press International TEXARKANA — Police said Wednesday that autopsies will help determine whether a city employee on the late shift at a water treatment plant shot and killed his co-worker of three years and then turned the gun on himself.

Pending those results, police were considering the deaths of Rex Drew, 26, and mrs said Drew had been shot three or four times with a .38-caliber weapon and Douglas was dead of one gunshot wound.
