Heart patients: Don't fear sex, professor says

United Press International NEW YORK — A medical professor wants to get the word out to men who have heart attacks that it's OK after recovery to resume sexual activity with a regular partner.

Dr. Gordon S. Walbroehl said many heart attack patients are physically able to resume sexual activity, but quite a few are afraid to do so.

They won't always mention their fears, Walbroehl said, so doctors should bring the subject up themselves.

Walbroehl, assistant professor in the Department of Family Practice at Wright State University School of Medicine, Dayton, Ohio, said fear of death or a repeat heart attack is the most frequent reason given for decreasing or not resuming sexual activity after leaving the hospital.

Another reason for the reluctance, he said, is that a major coronary event is a massive blow to the ego of male patients, forcing them to assume a passive role.

He believes if patients had the facts about having sex with their regular partners there would be fewer such fears.

"Recent surveys of both men and women patients showed that only about half (58 percent and 45 percent, respectively,) received information about postcoronary sexual activity before they were discharged from the hospital," he said.

In a report in American Family Physician, the journal of the American Academy of Family Physicians, Walbroehl encouraged doctors to defuse a patient's fears by letting them know:

"When most individuals walk five level blocks comfortably or climb two flights of stairs, usually they can safely resume sexual intercourse with a regular partner."

He said this is based on scientific monitoring of the heartbeat of postcoronary patients both during normal activities and during sex with their regular partners.

"The average maximal heart rate during sexual intercourse was 117 beats per minute, most identical to that of climbing two flights of stairs," said.

Extramarital sex, however, more hazardous.

The situation was not the same when heartbeats were monitored during extramarital sex involving the cardiac patients.

"Extramarital sex produces somewhat different — and perhaps more hazardous — pattern," Walbroehl said.

"For example, when one man had sexual intercourse with his girlfriend at noon, his heart rate increased from 96 to 150 beats per minute ... " the doctor wrote.

"Later that evening, he had intercourse with his regular partner, during which his heart rate increased from 72 to 110 beats per minute.
