

Gay reported competent despite tumor

LOS ANGELES — The father of slain soul singer Marvin
Gaye is suffering from a potentially fatal brain tumor, but is

Marvin Gaye — he alded an mentally competent to stand was a Grammy Awari-winning singer whose hits included "Heard It Through the Grape-vine" and "What's Going On." He was shot to dean in the famtrial on charges he shot his son to death, a psychiatrist testified Wednesday.

Physicians who diagnosed Marvin Gay Sr., 71, said he has a brain tumor the "size of a walnut." A defense attorney said that may have caused the be-havior leading to the April 1 shooting during a argument.

"Mr. Gay is competent to stand trial," Dr. Ronald Markman, a court appointed psychia-trist, said in a written report."
"He is fully oriented, alert,

aware of the nature of the proceedings and is open to sugges-tion and direction," the doctor

But after defense attorney Arnold Gold said further diagnosis of the tumor was needed, Superior Court Judge Michael Pirosh delayed ruling on Gay's competency until May 16.

Gold said the exact size and nature — whether benign or cancerous — of the tumor is un-known. But the attorney said it is "absolutely necessary" that the tumor be removed or Gay could be blind within months.


