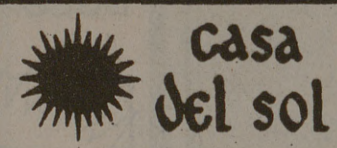

White neutral in Dem contest

United Press International AUSTIN — Gov. Mark White, rumored to be on Walter Mondale's list of potential vice presidential running mates, said Thursday he will remain neutral in the Democratic presidential campaign, at least for the time being.

The governor said he will participate in a precinct caucus in his hometown of Houston Saturday night and will register as uncommitted.

Asked if he would endorse a candidate prior to the Democratic National Convention in August, White said:

"I haven't decided on that yet. I rather doubt it, but I might. It may not be of any importance. My endorsement won't change one delegate vote there, I don't think."

White has repeatedly refused to say who he favors among Mondale, Colorado Sen. Gary Hart and Jesse Jackson although his chief political adviser, Dwayne Holman, has taken a leave of absence from the governor's staff to direct Mondale's Texas campaign.

Women bury fetus remains from trash

DALLAS — An abortion clinic has locked its trash dumpsters to stop Right to Life members from taking fetal remains for burial and sought to make arrangements with a laboratory for future disposal of the aborted fetuses.

Two members of Right to Life of Dallas, upset by the Dallas Women's Center Inc.'s manner of disposing of the fetuses, have been removing the remains from trash cans since February and holding burial services.

The women, identified only as Laura and Kay by the Dallas Times Herald, said they have buried about 900 fetuses.

Clinic director Linda Sprague said the facility's practice did not violate any laws.

"We are trying to find another means for disposing of the products of conception, not because we are in violation but because we are concerned about

New Mexico gas firm bankrupt; pensions so

EL PASO — Reorganization of the Jal Gas Co. of New Mexico will protect employees in the community and insure retirees of a continued pension, a spokesman for the El Paso Natural Gas Co. said Thursday.

Sam Beard, president of the Jal Gas Co., said the firm will continue to provide service to its customers while it prepares a plan to reorganize and settle debts. The continued service is required under the involuntary bankruptcy action filed in Albuquerque last week by El Paso Natural Gas, the Jal firm's chief supplier and creditor.

Filing of an involuntary bankruptcy action for the Jal Gas Co. was a necessary step toward correcting financial problems and making the firm a healthy entity, John McFall said.

"We want to protect the interest of employees in the Jal, N.M., and surrounding areas, especially the retirees of the

company who are living on pension checks," McFall said.

McFall said the bankruptcy action was brought about a number of incidents of mismanagement." But Beard attributed the financial problem to a New Mexico Public Commission ruling in case last November.

"We were served with a subpoena by the commission," said Wednesday. "In that they more or less demanded that we adequate our creditors. The rates sufficient to meet current obligations and the debt created by refurbishment system plant.

"We will continue to be in a day-to-day manner service being given by individual customers."
