The closing moments ...

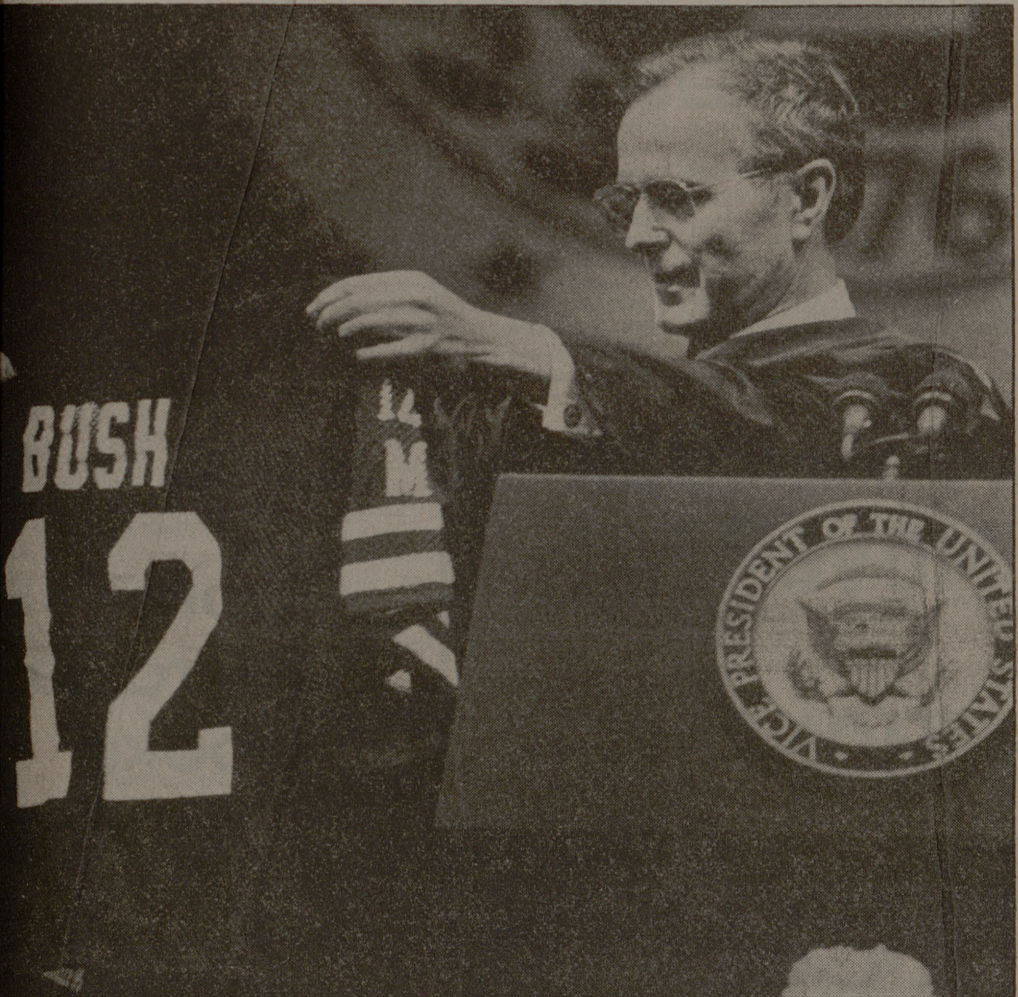
This weekend, about 3,300 Aggies said farewell to friends and became former students during commencement ceremonies held Friday and Saturday in G. Rollie White Coliseum. Friday afternoon, the graduates from the Colleges of Agriculture, Geosciences, and Liberal Arts heard San Antonio Mayor Henry Cisneros speak. That night Gov. Mark White spoke to graduates of the Colleges of Architecture and Environmental Design and Engineering. Saturday morning, graduates from the Colleges of Business Administration, Education, Science and Veterinary Medicine, and students from Texas A&M at Galveston listed to Vice President George Bush. Later that day, 153 cadets were commissioned into the U.S. Armed Forces by Gen. Paul X. Kelley.
