Hijackers refused asylum

CAIRO, Egypt — The two hijackers of an Iranian jetliner appeared stranded at a military airfield Wednesday after Egypt rejected their request for asylum and the plane's crew refused to take off, political sources said.

The two, described by the Al Akhbar newspaper as Iranian military officers opposed to the Islamic re-gime of Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini, hijacked the Boeing 727 over Iran Tuesday.

They made a refuelling stop at the Gulf state of Qatar, where they released 142 passengers and crew and then flew to Cairo.

Egypt promptly rejected their request for asylum. Officials, who handled a similar hijacking of an Iranian Fokker 27 less than two weeks ago, were reported to be angry at the repetition of the incident and eager to see the plane leave.

In Paris, a French government official said his country "does not accept air piracy. It is an act of violence that is unacceptable. We do not wish to see the plane land here."

But France had the same position on the last Iranian hijacking, and eventually let it land. The four hijackers were placed under house arrest in Bordeaux.

The plane's departure was delayed further because the three crewmen were reluctant to take off without rest, the sources said.
