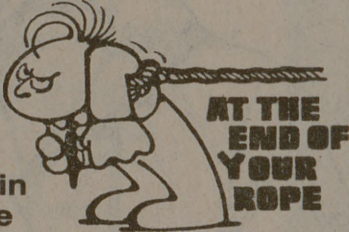

A noted authority on temperature regulation in mammals will lecture tomorrow at Texas A&M University.

Car seats on loan begins in August

A loan program to provide children's car seats, which comply with the new Texas child passenger protection law, will begin in mid-August.

The Texas Safety Association's loan program will allow people to borrow a car seat until they are able to purchase their own. The new Texas law, coupled with the increased number of infant deaths and injuries, led to the creation of the loan program.

The Texas child passenger protection law, effective Oct. 31, requires residents transporting children up to two-years-old to use federally approved child safety car seats. For children from ages two to four, the seat or a seatbelt may be used.

"These seats save lives and in many cases, prevent serious injury," said Anne Streetman, coordinator of the project in T.S.A.'s Austin office. "Those unable to purchase a seat can borrow one from us, until they're able to set aside enough money to buy their own. There's a nominal deposit, but it's refundable if the seat is returned in good condition."

The new law sets a \$50 fine for violation of this law, but the court will dismiss the fine if the violator provides proof of purchase or loan of a

seat within 10 days. Citations will not be issued until Jan. 1, 1985.

According to the Texas Department of Public Safety, 78 children up to four-years-old died last year as a result of non-pedestrian traffic accidents.

"A national study indicates the death and injury rate will be 70 percent to 90 percent lower after the law is in effect," Streetman said. "Texas is the 49th state to pass a child passenger protection law. We expect positive benefits from the new law and the loan program."

Three types of seats will be loaned. One seat is used only for infants. The second, for older children, can be used in the front or back seat of the car. The third seat, also for older children, allows the child to face the front or rear of the car in the front seat only.

"Infants in their first four months should be in a rear-facing seat, since they need extra protection in case of the impact of a collision," she said.

Streetman said the T.S.A. has 200 seats, which will be distributed from three locations: the T.S.A. Austin headquarters, the safety council in Dallas and the safety council in Houston.
