## Malaria vaccine advances

WASHINGTON — Government scientists Thursday reported two important advances in making a vaccine to ward off the most serious kind of malaria, still a major killer in many parts of the world.

Although researchers said large-scale production of an effective vaccine may yet be years away, the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases said the new developments bring such vaccines closer to reality.

One team of institute scientists, headed by Dr. Thomas McCutchan, devised a genetic engineering technique to cut intact genes directly out of the hereditary blueprints of the parasite that causes malaria.

Another team, directed by Dr. John Dame, applied that technique to the protozoa called a sporozoite that is injected by an infected mosquito into the blood stream. Dame cloned the gene that carries instructions to make the protein that alerts the body's immune system to attack the sporozoites when they enter the body.

The next step, Dame said, is to produce large amounts of the protein and then test it to see how effective it will be as a vaccine to create immunity against the sporozoite.


"One can't say that this is going to be the cure-all for malaria," Dame said in an interview.

There are four species of mosquito-borne organisms that cause malaria in humans. The current research zeros in on the kind — plasmodium falciparum — that causes most of the malaria fatalities.

Complicating the vaccine problem, however, is the fact that the parasites have four important stages in their life cycle and immunity against the sporozoites that start the infection in humans will not protect against the later stages.

Therefore, Dame said, a vaccine against the sporozoite must be capable of knocking out all the parasites to protect against disease.

## Texas economy good, report says

HOUSTON — Economic growth in Texas, buoyed by a population growth that should surpass that of the state of New York by the end of the decade, will remain "exceptional" through 1988, a report compiled by First City Bancorporation of Texas said Thursday.

"Texas' current recovery is being fueled as much by the strengthened national economy as it is by the now stabilized international energy markets," said Charles T. Franckle, vice president and chief economist for First City.

"Local labor, capital and technological resources will continue to adapt to the challenges of our expanding but now rapidly diversifying state economy."

Franckle said industrial production in Texas should expand 3.5 percent for 1984 after a 2 percent gain last year. A growth rate of 3.2 percent was forecast for 1985.

Consumer prices should stay at near national levels through 1988, Franckle said, after exceeding rates in the last five years.

"The state's cost of living will remain below the national average thanks to our favorable tax structure," he said.
