## Iraqi warplanes set oil platform on fire

KUWAIT — Iraqi warplanes attacked an Iranian oil platform Thursday, setting it ablaze in the second confirmed Iraqi airstrike in the Persian Gulf in 48 hours.

Both Iran and Iraq said the raid came around 5:50 a.m. (11:20 p.m.) near Kharg Island, Iran's principal oil exporting terminal and the target of a continuing Iraqi siege aimed at cutting off Iranian oil revenues.

The air strike followed an Iraqi attack Tuesday on a Greek-owned supertanker that signaled a resumption of Iraqi raids on neutral shipping in the Gulf after a nearly monthlong lull.

In the Iranian capital, official Tehran radio quoted Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini as saying Iraqi President Saddam Hussein would fail to defeat Iran because "Iraq is in turmoil and mixed up."

"This dishonorable guy will not destroy Kharg Island or Tehran even if he gets the power and the opportunity to try it because he cannot do so," the Iranian leader was quoted as saying. "He has already received a blow to his mouth."

IRNA, the official Iranian agency, said an unspecified number of Iraqi jet fighters streaked over the Gulf at dawn and attacked the Iranian oil pumping platform off the coast of Iran.

"The platform was set on fire and it was immediately extinguished by only minor damages," IRNA said. There was no report of casualties.

Official Baghdad radio broadcast monitored in Kuwait, Iraqi warplanes attacked what the radio described as "a large naval base" near Kharg Island, hitting "accurately and effectively."

"All planes returned safely to base," the radio said after the attack on Kharg Island, which sits 40 miles off the Iranian Gulf coast.

The phrase "a large naval base" generally means an oil tanker. Iraqi military parlance, but Iraqis presumably was referring to the oil platform.

## Three killed by bomb in Beirut street market

BEIRUT, Lebanon — A bomb tore through a busy street market in west Beirut Thursday, killing three people and wounding 25 amid a new outbreak of fighting that shook Lebanon's hope for peace.

Witnesses said the blast from the bomb smashed scores of windows and blew scraps from splintered vegetable carts over a wide area.

Heavily armed soldiers and Moslem militiamen swarmed through the crowded Moslem quarter of Basta looking for the bombers, unleashing warning shots to clear the way for ambulances. They arrested 10 Christians and beat them up before releasing them, Christian Phalange radio said.

Three people were killed and 25 injured in the blast, state Beirut radio said.


But an hour later stall-holders again were doing brisk business in the market, some laughing and sporting blood-stained bandages.

Witnesses said the bomb was placed on top of an empty oil drum by a passing motorist. Phalange radio said it exploded as garbage being cleared from behind vegetable sellers' carts. Two of the dead were municipal workers.

Security sources could not immediately explain the purpose of the bombing.

In the Shouf mountains, Moslem and Christian militiamen battled with cannons, rockets and heavy machineguns despite a truce decision Wednesday to separate the army between their front lines.

A cease-fire halted the fighting three hours after shooting ended.
