

HOUSTON — Texas Agrico Commissioner Jim Hightower into town on an 18-wheel truck of watermelons Tuesday to dra tention to the state's program farmers market their produ

rectly to food stores.
"It's often been said that I'm dumb I came to town on a low watermelons. Well, I did that! to link up producers with sel Hightower said.

Hightower led a procession lawmakers and 17 member newly-formed co-op of 17 melon farmers from Hem who have arranged to sell I m pounds of melons this seasont 103 Kroger stores in Houston Texas Department of Agricu new direct marketing program

Under the program, the TDA ches small farmers how to org and market their produce direc

food stores. The Kroger chain is the first pany to take part in the program Houston.

"For years, these farmers in Hempstead area have prosome of the finest-tasting wat ons in the United States, but portion of their crop has rot because they lacked access nificant markets, like House Hightower said.

Through direct marketing, farmers sell more of their pro for a higher price, thus enabling stores to pay less for the produ eliminating the middleman erally wholesalers. "This is important on three

els," Hightower said. "The fam who didn't have a market be now has one and they're get three times the prices for t goods. "But the consumer gets che prices and a higher quality me market. And the Texas econol benefits because instead of buy

melons from Georgia, we're bu

Texas melons from Texas far and the money stays in the sta Hightower said.
Ollie Williams, president of Hempstead farmers co-op, sa members previously sold their termelons at roadside stands farmers' markets for about 1 ce 3 cents per pound. Now, they

earning 6 cents to 7¼ cents pound for the melons, Williams "We've increased our profits percent per acre," Williams said The co-op members farm a 700 acres in the Hempstead are the past, they have sold just one percent of their average cro


25,000 pounds of watermelons. Co-op members are now 5 90 percent of their produce Kroger.

The co-op shipped its first low watermelons to Kroger's House warehouse on July 12.

Bob Everingham, vice presi of Kroger's Houston marke area, said the agreement helps company increase minority P pation in its stores and also hel firm maintain lower food price
