



## Offensive D Punch... C



At top left, Texas A&M place kicker Alan Smith (I) celebrates with teammate Kyle Stuard (4) after kicking his fifth field goal against Arkansas State to tie the latime Southwest Conference record for most field goal in a single game. Smith finished 1983 as the SWCs wond leading scorer with 18 field goals and 18 PATs. At top right, Aggie quarterback Kevin Murray (14) role out to look for his receivers downfield against the University of Houston last year. Murray, a sophomor from Dallas, was chosen as the Southwest Conference Offensive Newcomer of the Year in 1983.
