## Super Bowl is a tough act to follow

HOUSTON — It seems just yesterday that the Los Angeles Raiders won the Super Bowl. Coach Tom Flores says that is almost too true.

The Raiders and the Houston Oilers open their regular seasons today in the Astrodome. While Flores does not detect any overconfidence on his team that was 1-3 in the season, he said the Super Bowl does present a preparation problem for the winner in the season after.

"When you win a Super Bowl you're playing almost until February and then by the time you come to that Super Bowl high it's March and before you realize it you're in training camps and eventually right into summer camps," he said.

"It comes awfully quick and think sometime players and the coaches and the whole organization might not be ready for it, emotionally, mentally and physically," he said.

But Flores has experience coaching a defending champion, the Raiders won the 1981 Super Bowl.

"Some of the players were not in physical shape," he said of the returning 1981 team. "They felt they could crank it up when they had and we didn't."

"Right now we have about 50 percent of our squad that was here in 1981 and the memories were with them and the entire off-season. They came to camp (this year) physically ready to compete," he said.

No team has ever won consecutive Super Bowls but Flores says, "We're bound and determined to have a good season and destroy some of the myths that have occurred around the world about how it's almost impossible to repeat."

He admits there will be challenges to that effort and includes the Oilers among them.

"There's no question the Oilers are much better this year with (coach Hugh) Campbell and (quarterback Warren) Moon playing the way he is. With the leadership that they have, they just seem to be playing with more enthusiasm. They seem to be all on the same page."

"One of the things that bothers me is that his staff is not knowing exactly how they're going to do what they're going to do. Anything you get a new coaching staff, you're not sure how they are going to approach a regular season game," he said.

Well, if the Oilers have the Raiders worried about the opener, there is a healthy amount of respect being paid from the other side as well. Especially Moon, who faces one of the best NFL defenses in his league but.
