



Did you know that now you can earn dorm points by playing on a Corec Intramural Team? Beginning August 27, 1984, a new corec point system will be implemented. Men's and women's dorms will now be able to compete in corec sports and earn points for their respective dorms. Dorms may compete in all corec sports (team and dual sports) with either dorms or independents of the opposite sex. However, you must remember to declare the name of the dorm on the entry card and you must meet all dorm and Intramural-Recreational Sports Eligibility Rules throughout the sports season. Any dorm(s) team(s) failing to clarify what dorm or dorms they represent will be considered an independent corec team and will not
