**McEnroe reaches
the quarterfinals**

NEW YORK — John McEnroe patiently sat out two rain delays Tuesday before beating qualifier Robert Green, 6-3, 6-2, 6-2, to reach the quarterfinals of the \$2.5 million U.S. Open Tennis Championships.

The top seed from New York won the first nine points of the match, but after that Green made a creditable showing, breaking McEnroe's service in the third game and then holding for 2-2.

Green, a 24-year-old from Boston who is ranked 132nd in the world, actually took more games from McEnroe than anyone else did in three previous matches.

He also came up with the best line of the tournament, saying, "Waiting in the locker room before the match you had to feel a lot like Gary Gilmore (an executed killer and the subject of Norman Mailer's "The Executioner's Song"), "waiting for someone to come and get you."

When the rain finally stopped at night, Britain's John Lloyd completed a 4-6, 6-4, 6-4, 6-2 upset of ninth seed Henrik Sundstrom, and No. 4 Mats Wilander defeated Tim Mayotte, 6-4, 6-4, 7-6 (7-2), in a match that started the night before.

Also, the women's quarterfinal bracket was completed when Sylvia Hanika beat Petra Huber, 6-4, 7-5.

Lloyd, ranked 49th in the world, 40 places behind Sundstrom, was at his best in the fourth set, when he broke service in the third and seventh games, and he said, "The fourth set was probably the best set I've ever played in terms of the pressure on me."

Lloyd, whose match record this year is a modest 17-14, is the first British man to reach the quarterfinals of the U.S. National championships during the Open era. Mark Cox advanced that far in 1966 when the tournament was amateur.

The match was delayed twice by rain, for a total of 4 hours and 33 minutes, starting at 1:21 p.m. EDT and winding up at 8:14 p.m.

"It was an incredible day, one of those days that just seemed to go on forever," the 30-year-old Briton said. "It was probably the longest day of my life in terms of match play. I've had delays before, but not in such a major tournament at such a crucial point."

In the quarterfinals Lloyd will meet the winner of the Jimmy Connors-Joakim Nystrom match.

The Wilander-Mayotte match was suspended at 3-3 in the opening set because of rain Monday night, and

when play resumed the Swede the opening set with a break, 10th game on a lob.

Wilander broke in the game of the second set, though Mayotte got that back in the ninth game, Wilander again the 10th to go up two sets.

Twice in the third set went up a break, but Wilander the second one back in a game to force the tie-break, he won 7-2.

In his four matches, McEnroe yielded a mere 19 games, dropping a set. He also had a match record for 1984 to 66.

"I hadn't seen him play a lot of people told me about him," McEnroe said, "aware of the fact he had a good game to force the tie-break, he won 7-2."

The start of the match was delayed for 2 hours and 5 minutes because of rain, and there was a suspension of play for a half hour in the second set because of light rainfall.

When the players returned following the second delay, McEnroe ripped off 16 of the first 17 points through the next four games and take the set. He then lost the third and fifth games in the third set.

"I had the chance to win which helped me because I really prepared the way I have liked," McEnroe said. "It's just experience. I'm usually a good starter. I was maybe he just felt a little gish."

The actual time of the match was an hour and 31 minutes and McEnroe had an impressive first percentage of 73 percent. He registered only one ace for Green, a strong 6-foot-pounder.

Unseeded John Lloyd won No. 9 Henrik Sundstrom, 4-6, 6-4, when their fourth round two-round was delayed a third time by rain.

Because of the rain, the women's quarterfinal between the Czech Mandlikova and Carling was postponed until Wednesday.

The men were scheduled to complete their quarterfinal Tuesday with Mats Wilander against Tim Mayotte and Tomas Smid against Gene Mayer in the afternoon. McEnroe next met Smid-Mayer survivor.

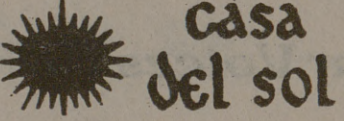
