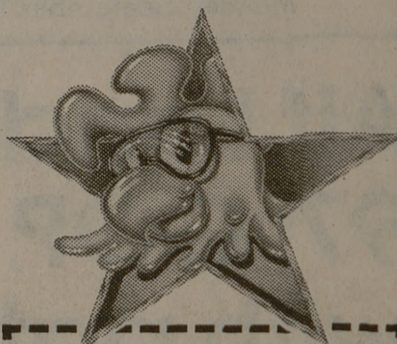

State Fair of Texas sets ride standards

DALLAS — New safety standards for rides at the State Fair of Texas are so impressive they are being used as a national model, says a federal safety inspector.

State Fair of Texas officials developed the standards last May following the Oct. 17, 1983, crash of a gondola on the Enterprise ride. One man died in the incident and 17 people were injured.

The new measures include detailed inspections on all rides that are built on the fair's midway and extensive checks of those rides that are permanent, said fair spokeswoman Nancy Wiley.

Nancy Steorts, who chairs the National Consumer Product Commission, praised the new procedures.

"I think they have been diligent and are to be commended," she said. "I worked closely on the Enterprise problem. I was there and saw the result of the tragedy."

Fair officials have inspected permanent rides and have operators fully disassembled for thorough inspection before they are reassembled.

The 1984 State Fair of Texas runs from Oct. 5-28.
