## Volunteers to search for voters

 AUSTIN — Saying it was a "vivid reminder" of the civil rights campaign 20 years ago, Secretary of State Myra McDaniel Monday announced a voter registration drive aimed at the Austin's 15,000 bus riders.

McDaniel and organizers of the registration effort said volunteers would board municipal buses at peak periods today in hopes of registering 1,000 new voters. Jeanne Lawson, an organizer of the event, said similar campaigns may be held in Dallas and El Paso.

McDaniel became the highest ranking black in state government with her appointment as secretary of state last week.

"Twenty odd years ago, our nation witnessed massive voter registration drives in other parts of this country," she said. "The benefits reached from the efforts of that non-partisan registration program are indisputable."

McDaniel said the low voter turnout these days is attributable more to apathy than denial of rights. Slightly more than half of the eligible voters cast ballots in the 1980 presidential election.

"I think today the situation is different (than the 1960s)," she said. "I don't think too many people are intimidated to vote. But I also think too many people forget."

McDaniel estimated that 14.3 million Texans are eligible to vote, although only 7.5 million are registered. To be eligible to vote in the Nov. 6 general election, potential voters must register by Oct. 7.

McDaniel, who is to be formally sworn in as secretary of state today, said she was opposed to letting people register on election day.

"I think with all the scandals we've had over the years in Duval County, that's not a very good idea," she said. "You need time to check out applications and you can't do that on election day."

It was from the Duval County area that vote returns from the infamous "box 13" gave former President Lyndon Johnson a narrow 1948 U. S. Senate victory.
