redo the picture. It's impossible. Gary Busey is the Bear."

Sarafian agrees with Spangler's assessment.

"The success of the characterization is due to Gary Busey," he said. "He's such a four-dimensional actor. He lets us inside to see the thinking process going on. We can see him think."

Overall, Sarafian says he is very pleased with the results of his work. He now awaits the public's reaction.

"I think there will be a bit of

controversy, which is fine," he said. "I just don't know everyone's reaction."

"There was a write-up in the press back in Alabama where some ball player said the A&M sequences weren't accurate. How in the hell does he know? He wasn't there. Where does he get off saying that? Now, Gene Stallings was there and he was at my side most of the time."

One part of the film which might cause that controversy is the Junction training camp sequence. When Bryant arrived at Texas A&M, he took the team

off to Junction, Texas, and put them through his own training system. Many have called it brutal.

"Well, I don't think it's brutal," Sarafian said. "I think he showed a lot of compassion and I think the majority of the players don't regret it."

"What happened had its purpose and, you know what I mean, it's the difference between winners and losers. I don't think the Bear would have done it if it was wrong."

"Everyone will have their own interpretation. I had a

good friend call me today and say, 'Dick, when he took them out in the rain, that was wrong. You shouldn't have shot it.' But he did — he had them out there. He was a rascal. He was a very attractive rascal."

Sarafian said he hopes the film shows a true picture of a special man. And he says that Texas A&M was a big help.

"I think everything turned out real well," he said. "If you get a chance, thank everyone down at Texas A&M for me. They kicked it off for me and we were able to get in and out and

they did a good job."

"I didn't get to see much of the campus, just bonfire and the game from the sidelines, but if the guys I met were an honest sampling, it's a great place."

"The game was good for Gary to be there and react to what was going on."

"Overall, the general talk I'm getting from people is that they love the A&M sequences. They are very good. They have a lot of detail, a lot of production."

"We anticipate a very positive reaction."
